Why I Wake Early





Maria Anna Froon

Maria Anna Froon was born in 1928 in Holland, where in her early years she was a kindergarten teacher, who loved the children she taught. Maria spent her teenage years under the reign of the dreaded Adolf Hitler during World War 2. At this time Hitler was conquering the small countries around Germany. Maria said they only had a cup of soup per day, however she was sent to work on a farm where the farmers replenished their food with lots of porridge to keep up their strength to work the fields. In 1955 she met and married Antoon Froon a farmer, They came to Australia as there was no land available to work in Holland. They found work in King Lake where Antoon was a potato farmer for 15 years. They then came to Deniliquin where Antoon worked in the rice mills, Maria continued to devote her life looking after their children. She was always available to help others in need. Antoon lost the use of his legs so they moved into Navorina in December 2022. Unfortunately Antoon passed away last February. Maria is very happy here with life in Navorina and joins in every activity available to her. Like all of us here Maria intends to see out her days as a resident. A very lovely lady indeed.
