Hello Residents, Families and Friends!

Welcome to the August edition of our newsletter! What a huge few months we have had, and so much on the go at the moment.

We are currently recruiting a Director of Care and a Quality Manager, hopefully this process will not take too long.



The development application will be submitted to Council shortly for the Vergola in the center courtyard. This will be great for everyone, especially as we are planning to open the Café later this year. The outdoor garden upgrades are in progress and there is still a lot to complete such as stenciling of the concrete and the indigenous artwork in conjunction with Yukawa. The due date for the indoor furniture is Friday 16 August and the new outdoor furniture has arrived ready to be placed out soon. Aged Care Employee Day is on August 7, Navorina is lucky to have such a dedicated staff and we would like to take this opportunity to thank each one of them for their service.

We are currently implementing a new internal audit, industry benchmarking tool, survey tool and Continuous Quality Improvement Program called MOA benchmarking. We are also upgrading our Call Bell system (also known as Nurse Call) to help improve resident outcomes with the latest technology.

Local Government Elections 2024 - Saturday, 14th September 2024 Voting Services for Residents.

The upcoming Local Government Elections will be held on Saturday, 14th September 2024. The NSWEC plans to provide voting services to electors who are residents in facilities who otherwise may not be able to attend a polling place on election day. Navorina Nursing Home has been identified as a facility that may have residents who would benefit from a visit to your facility by NSWEC Election Officials who will issue votes to residents of the facility. A visit of this kind would take place in the week prior to Election Day. Residents of the facility who are enrolled in the facility's Local Government Area.

There is no absent voting. More information will be provided closer to the date.



When the noon sun shines bright and high, And shadows dance and breezes sigh, A loyal friend is by my side, A dog whose love will never hide.


Through fields of green and skies of blue, He walks with me, so tried and true. With every step, a wagging tail, In joy and sorrow, without fail.


