REMINDER OF UPDATED COVID RESTRICTIONS

A reminder for all visitors entering Navorina.

The restrictions are as follows:

- You **must** wear a **mask** at all times.
This means no eating or drinking whilst you are in the facility. If you need to eat or drink you can do so in the rotunda area, but must be 1.5m away from residents.
- All visitors must be double vaccinated for Covid-19
- Only 2 visitors per resident / per day. All visits must be in the residents' rooms. 2 visitors under the age of 12 are now welcome as long as they are with a double vaccinated adult.
